Art Shelter, BERLIN

Deadline for applications: **17 April, (Sunday), 2022.**

Through this open call, Art Shelter expresses its solidarity with Ukrainian contemporary artists in this difficult time of war.

The start of the program is in May, 2022.

What does Art Shelter offer?

- 2 apartments in total with 500sqm of space
- Bedrooms with possibility to be used single or shared with in total 12-20 persons
- Common rooms in which artists can share the working space
- Open Studio and opportunity to present your work to a professional audience and the community
- We welcome family members and children as well with the possibility for them to stay in the same room as the artist

What are the financial conditions?

- Art Shelter is a private initiative and is being financed through the government funding for Ukrainian refugees in Germany
- Your registration as refugee in Berlin is required which will secure the state of Berlin to pay the monthly rent and minimum living expenses based on German law
- You will receive the relevant documentation for the registration and will receive guidance by the art manager of the Art Shelter

Other IMPORTANT Requirements

- The artists are required to help with furnishing the apartment such as putting furniture together and installing appliances
- Funding or furniture will be provided through donations

What is the duration?

It is possible to stay up to 12 months in the Art Shelter

Who can apply?

Ukrainian female and LGBTQ+ artists working in the fields of contemporary painting, sculpture, installation, multimedia, video, film, photography, sound, music, performance or multidisciplinary forms.

What are the requirements?

- Interest in Berlin art scene
- Awareness of community requirements
- Good knowledge of English or German
